EDUCATIONAL INITIATIVES




BACK TO SCHOOL DRIVE

FAST A THON


Annually, we hold a dinner where Muslims and non-Muslims can join us in fasting, and then breaking the fast, during Ramadan, our month of fasting.

Our goal is to supplement the families' needs and ease and shorten the transition. We follow these protocols:




2016 Refugee work in Numbers:






